EARLY YEARS INDUCTION PROGRAMME

Starting school is an enormous milestone in your child's life and one that we want you to enjoy and celebrate with us. Your child is as important to us as they are to you. We will endeavour to visit them in their pre-school setting, where covid restrictions allow. Those who do not attend nursery will be able to visit us at school so do not worry that they will not have the opportunity to meet some of the staff team. 



Behaviour at Mundella

Rationale

Getting Ready

We will provide your child with their Mundella book bag which they will need to bring to school for their home reading books. Please check it daily as communications and special pictures will come home to you inside it. We will also provide a Mundella water bottle which your child will also need to have labelled with their name and carried to school separately from their book bag (they tend to leak after a while). The children will be provided with a drink of milk or water during morning break and some fresh fruit. Breakfast bagels and fruit are also provided in class on a daily basis at 8:30, free of charge. The children will receive a school house coloured PE top during their first week which they will wear for PE lessons. It is really important that ALL items of school uniform are labelled as it makes it easier to reunite any lost property with its owner.
