Collective Worship Policy

1. The aim of this policy is to provide an opportunity for pupils to:
 - Worship God
 - Reflect on values that are of a broadly Christian nature and on their own beliefs
 - Develop a community spirit, a common ethos and shared values
 - Consider spiritual and moral issues
 - Respond to the worship offered
2. We will provide daily collective worship for our registered pupils (apart from those who have been withdrawn by their parents).
3. The Headteacher is responsible (under the Schools Standards and Framework Act 1998) for arranging daily collective worship after consulting with the Governing Body. Daily worship will be wholly or mainly of a broadly Christian character. The precise nature will depend on background, ages and abilities of the children. Collective worship will:
 - Be acceptable to the whole community, staff and pupils.
 - Include a variety of elements at different times.
 - Involve the pupils.
4. The school will review this policy annually and assess its implementation and effectiveness. The policy will be promoted and implemented throughout the school.
