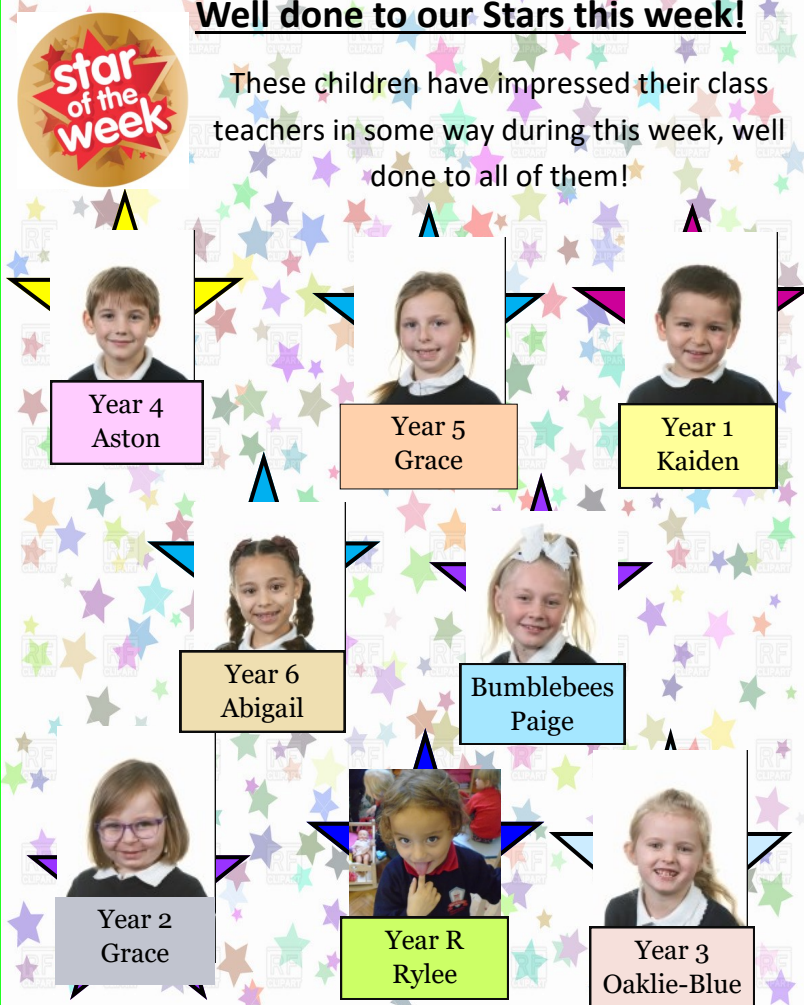
Thank you for making this day a success; raising £134.63, and thank you for continuing to support charitable activities at Mundella Primary School.

### Reminder: After School Clubs

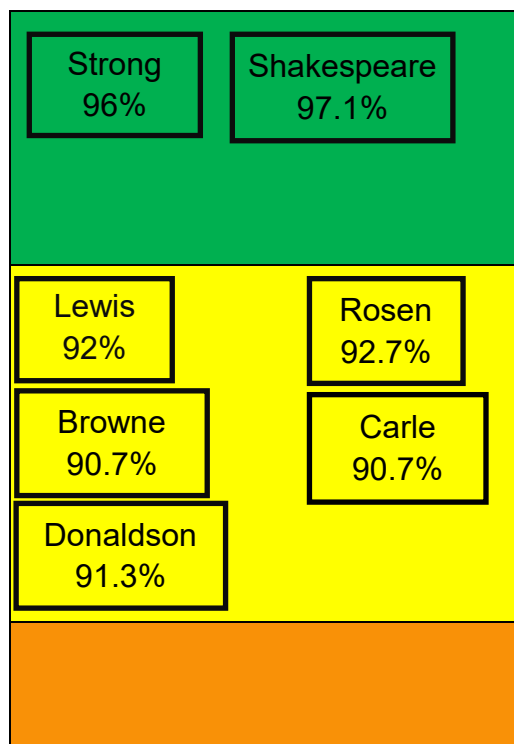

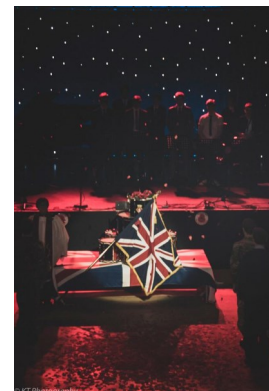
Well done to the classes in green and we hope all our poorly children are fighting fit for next week!
