Dear Parents/Carers,

Although we have lots more to fit in to the next few months, it is time to start talking about some of our plans for the summer.

In previous years we have had mixed responses to availability of summer activities, but we are going to give things a try, again, this year. Therefore, I would like to tell you about our Mundella Summer Club and Springboard initiatives.

Our Summer Club will be open to all pupils and, as long as the children attend, will be entirely free. It will be for five days over the week beginning 26th July during which time pupils will be engaging in enriching activities that will feed their imaginations and exercise their brains and bodies; including science, drama, art, music, coding, cooking, finance and much more.

Our Springboard will be directed towards our current Year 5 pupils but, depending on numbers, will then be filled with pupils from Y4 and Y3. This will be for four days from the 23rd of August. The springboard programme will have more of a focus towards getting ready for the new school. As well of elements of maths and English we will also look at music, drama and science.

Numbers for both weeks will be limited and, although they will be entirely free, parents will be asked to provide an initial deposit (£25 for Summer Club and £20 for Springboard) which will be returned to them as long as their children attend the sessions.

More details will follow next week and we will start taking names before the half term break.
