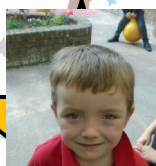
We are also looking into the idea of having the field open for your use after school each day. If you are interested in being part of a group that would help organise this please let me know.

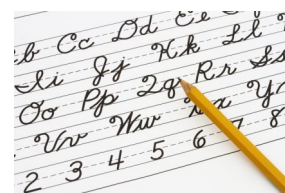

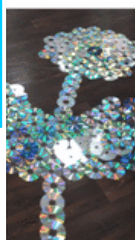
