Gates will open at 8:30 each morning, closing at 8:50. Any arrivals after this time will be considered late.

The main Walton Road gate (with buzzer) will be for years 4,5 and 6 to come onto the playground, the lower Walton Road gate will be for years R,1,2 and 3.

We ask that parents do not come onto the playground in the morning. If you need to speak to the office, please phone us. However, if it is something that can only be dealt with in person then please have a seat in the waiting area where somebody will come out to see you.

Only one adult to collect from the playground in the afternoon, please wear a face covering.

As instructed by the government, schools are to reopen fully for ALL children. Therefore, pupil's attendance will be mandatory from Monday 8th March. Non-attendance will be unauthorised (unless for a usually authorised reason).
