Single use plastics, what are they?

Single-use plastic, also known as disposable plastic, are products that we use once every day prior to being thrown away or recycled. Products that are made from single-use plastic include plastic carrier bags, food packaging, cutlery, straws, disposable cups, cartons and bottles. Unfortunately, a lot of these products cannot be recycled and end up in landfills or as ocean pollution.

If one child has a new carton or bottle in their lunch they will have added around 200 items to this problem in one year. If half of our children do the same that number would be about 20,000 items.

If you stack 20,000 small water bottles end to end they would be about double the height of Ben Nevis.

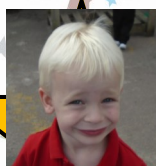
Do your bit and avoid using single use plastics. We are making a whole heap of rubbish for our children to deal with.

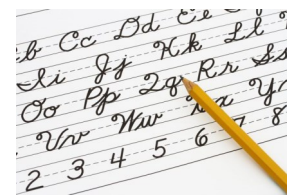
