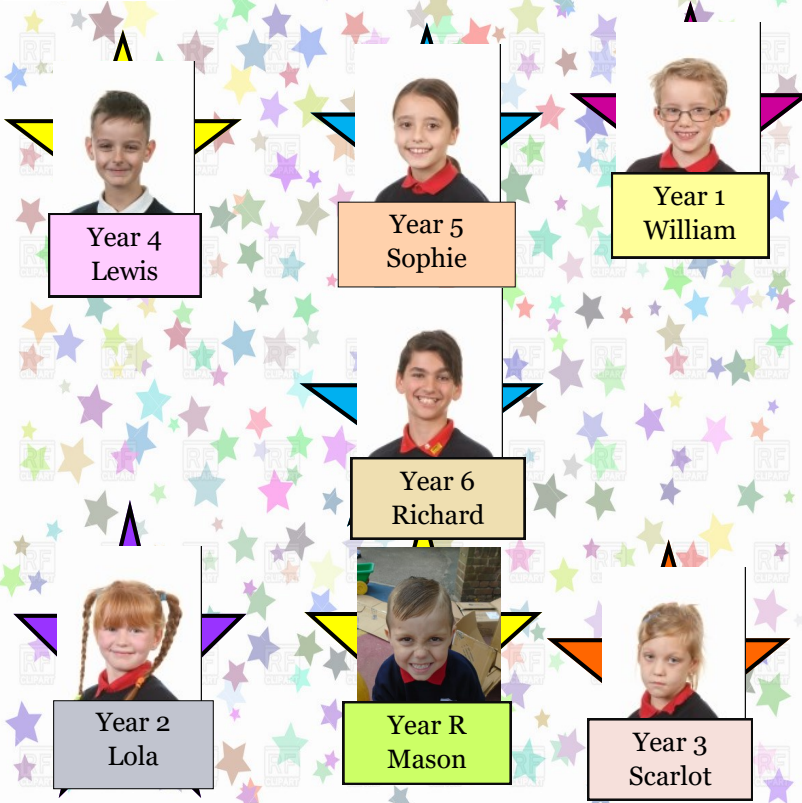

Punctuality Pup and Attendance Ted!



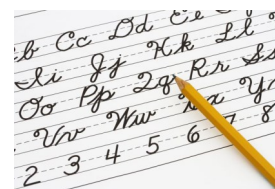

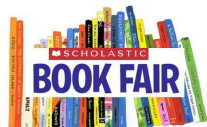

Thank you to everyone who attended the school book fair this week, we took £515.52 through sales of the books which earns £206 in rewards to spend with Scholastic for books for the school.

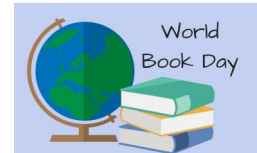

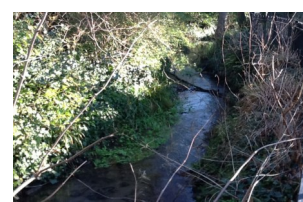
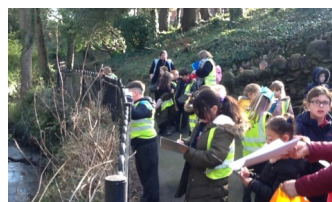
World Book Day
